TRANSFERABLE SKILLS

Transferable skills are critical to success on any job. Transferable skills are any skills that you have learned in one context that can be used in another. For example, if a learner has been helping out at his neighbour's beauty salon and learned how to communicate clearly on the phone from there, then he can transfer that skill to another job that might require customer service assignments. Or, if a student learned how to organize multiple projects from a teacher she had in middle school, she can transfer that skill to a job that might require organizational skills.
